### **2021 CABERNET SAUVIGNON, PASO ROBLES** **90 POINTS / GOLD MEDAL / EXCEPTIONAL / BEST BUY**

Garnet color. Aromas and flavors of ripe black currant, black cherry, vanilla, and fig with a round, lively, dry medium body and a tingling, interesting, medium-length finish revealing notes of red cherry, cassis, plum, and spice and leather with well-integrated, chewy tannins and light oak flavor. A pleasingly ripe table wine for all manner of cuisine or occasions.



### **2022 CHARDONNAY, MONTEREY COUNTY** **88 POINTS / SILVER MEDAL / HIGHLY RECOMMENDED / BEST BUY**

Light golden straw color. Aromas and flavors of orange juice, canned pineapple, and citrus cream egg white foam with a round, lively, dry medium body and a tingling, appealing, medium-length finish manifesting overtones of pineapple cream pie, orange creamsicle, green apple, and slightly bitter herbs with light oak flavor. A lovely aromatic lift from the Viognier makes this Chardonnay a highly versatile sipper for many meal pairings.



### **2019 PINOT NOIR, MONTEREY COUNTY** **88 POINTS / SILVER MEDAL / HIGHLY RECOMMENDED / BEST BUY**

Ruby color. Aromas and flavors of cherry compote and granola, vanilla mocha, black tea leaves, and sandalwood with a round, vibrant, dry medium body and a tingling, interesting, medium-length finish displaying suggestions of raspberry tart, tea box, and macadamia gelato with medium, well-integrated tannins and light oak flavor. An approachable and versatile Pinot Noir that will be a hit at the dinner table.
